

META LANGUAGE SCHOOL USA LEVELS

Beginner levels

Starter
This course is the lowest level offered and is designed for low beginners. Starter covers English basics such as the verb to be, simple questions and answers, basic adjectives, simple past tense, colors, clothes, and everyday vocabulary.

Book 1
This course is designed for mid beginners and reinforces and builds upon what was learned in Starter. It introduces countries, leisure activities, pronunciation practice, and count/non-count nouns.

Book 2
This course is designed for high beginners and reinforces and builds upon what was learned in Level 1. It introduces multiple verb tenses, including past simple vs. past continuous, conditionals, and introduces the present perfect and present perfect continuous. Level 2 is the highest level in the beginner module.

Intermediate levels

Book 3
This course is designed for low intermediate learners and reinforces and builds upon Level 2. It introduces the passive voice, parts of speech, modal verbs, and strengthens pronunciation and speaking skills.

Book 4
This course is designed for mid intermediate learners and reinforces and builds upon Level 3. It introduces expressions with modal verbs, idiomatic expressions, real and unreal conditionals, and reported speech.

Book 5
This course is designed for high intermediate learners and reinforces and builds upon Level 4. It introduces discourse markers, literal vs. metaphorical language, and defining and non-defining relative clauses. Level 5 is the highest level in the intermediate module.

Advance/Specialization levels

Pathway A
Q: Skills for Success – Q 1 to Q 5
This course is designed to develop students' academic English and critical thinking skills needed for college and university study. The series gives emphasis on academic vocabulary, note-taking, presentations, research skills, and task-based learning aligned with higher education expectations.

This course offers business-related concepts and language to help students apply English immediately in professional contexts, developing practical communication skills for the workplace.
